

Blue Wave Dishtowel Crochet Pattern

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<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo</i> – yarn over• <i>sl</i> – slip stitch• <i>sc</i> – single crochet• <i>hdc</i> – half double crochet stitch• <i>2hdctog</i> – half double crochet stitch decrease	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 2 – 2.5 Lily Sugar n Cream in blue jean and white or any other worsted weight 100% cotton yarn approx 2.5 oz of of color A and 2 oz color B.
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special stitch -2 half double crochet stitch decrease– Yarn over, insert hook in specified stitch and draw up a loop; three loops on the hook, Keeping these three loops on hook, yarn over and draw up a loop in the next stitch, then draw through all 5 stitches

You can make a larger or smaller dishtowel or a blanket by using 12 +2 chain.

Approx. 15 in x 21 in (38 cm x 53 cm)

Color A – White Chain 50

Row 1 – crochet *hdc* in 3 chain from hook

*Work 1 *hdc* in each of the next 3 *ch*. In the next 2 chains, *2hdctog* (Yarn over, insert hook in specified stitch and draw up a loop; three loops on the hook, Keeping these three loops on hook, yarn over and draw up a loop in the next stitch, then draw through all 5 stitches). *2hdctog* again in the next two chains. Work 1 *hdc* in each of the next 3 CH, then work 2 *hdc* in next CH, and another 2 *hdc* in the next chain.

Repeat from * across to the last *ch*. 2 *hdc* into that last *ch*. *Ch* 2 and turn.

Row 2: hdC in the next stitch

*Work 1 *hdc* in each of the next 3 *ch*. In the next two chains, *2hdctog*. Then *2hdctog* again in the next two chains. Work 1 *hdc* in each of the next 3 *ch*, then work 2 *hdc* in next *ch*, and another 2 *hdc* in the next chain.

Repeat from * across to the last *ch*. Work 2 *hdc* into the top of the *ch* 2 turning chain from the previous row. *Ch* 2 and turn.

Repeat row 2 for the rest of the dishtowel until you reach your desired length.

Color changes: 4 rows of white, 2 rows blue, 1, row white, 2 rows blue, 6 rows white, 8 rows blue, 6 rows white, 2 rows blue, 1 row white, 2 rows blue, 4 rows white

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
