

Herringbone Double Dish Cloth Pattern

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Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 1 – 2.5 Lily Sugar n Cream in yellow and hot orange or any other worsted weight 100% cotton yarn.	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">yo – yarn oversl – slip stitchsc – single crochethbdc – herringbone double crochet
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special stitch -herringbone double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **yo** pull through 1 loop on the hook, **yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

Approx. 13.5 in x 13.5 in (33 cm x 33 cm)

Color A – Yellow - Chain 36

Row 1: **hbdc** in the 3rd chain from hook repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn (34 st)

Row 2: **hbdc** in the first **hbdc** repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn (34 st)

Row 3: Repeat row 2 until you have 16 rows. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends.

Border -Color B -Orange

Pull up a stitch on either the top of bottom and single crochet around in each stitch. On the sides space the stitches evenly, 3 stitches for each hbdc. 2 in the top part of the stitch and one where the stitch is worked into the row. Crochet 3 single crochet in each corner. Sl and then chain 1. Do another row of single crochet around.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy.

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
