Herringbone Double Dish Cloth Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
 Scissors tapestry needle <u>H, 5 mm crochet hook</u> 1 – 2.5 Lily Sugar n Cream in <u>yellow</u> and hot orange or any other 	 yo – yarn over sl – slip stitch sc – single crochet hbdc – herringbone double crochet
worsted weight 100% cotton yarn.	

special stitch -herringbone double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. *yo* and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. *yo* pull through 1 loop on the hook, *yo*, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

Approx. 13.5 in x 13.5 in (33 cm x 33 cm)

Color A – Yellow - Chain 36

Row 1: *hbdc* in the 3rd chain from hook repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn (34 st) Row 2: *hbdc* in the first *hbdc* repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn (34 st) Row 3: Repeat row 2 until you have 16 rows. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends.

Border - Color B - Orange

Pull up a stitch on either the top of bottom and single crochet around in each stitch. On the sides space the stitches evenly, 3 stitches for each hbdc. 2 in the top part of the stitch and one where the stitch is worked into the row. Crochet 3 single crochet in each corner. SI and then chain 1. Do another row of single crochet around.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy.

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
