Leaf Ripple Blanket Crochet Pattern

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Abbreviations – US Terms

- *yo* yarn over
- sl slip stitch
- sc single crochet
- *hdc* half double crochet stitch
- 2*hdctog* half double crochet stitch decrease
- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- H 5 mm crochet hook
- 3 10.5 ball of Bernat Velvet Yarn
 Frosted Pine or any bulky gauge 5 yarn (315 yd)
- 1 10.5 ball Bernat Velvet Yarn
 <u>Smokey Green</u> or any bulky gauge 5 yarn (315 yd)

special stitch -2 half double crochet stitch decrease—Yarn over, insert hook in specified stitch and draw up a loop; three loops on the hook, Keeping these three loops on hook, yarn over and draw up a loop in the next stitch, then draw through all 5 stitches .You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using 12 +2 chain.

Gauge: 5 in x 5 in = 9 rows of x 14 stitches (12.7 cm)

Approx. 36 in x 56 in (91.44 cm x 142.24 cm)

Color A - Dark Green - Chain 98

Row 1 – crochet *hdc* in 3 chain from hook *Work 1 *hdc* in each of the next 3 *ch*. In the next 2 chains, **2***hdctog* (Yarn over, insert hook in specified stitch and draw up a loop; three loops on the hook, Keeping these three loops on hook, yarn over and draw up a loop in the next stitch, then draw through all 5 stitches). **2***hdctog* again in the next two chains(1 stitch). Work 1 *hdc* in each of the next 3 CH, then work 2 *hdc* in next CH, and another 2 *hdc* in the next chain.

Repeat from * across to the last *ch*. 2 *hdc* into that last *ch*. *Ch* 2 and turn.

Row 2: hdC in the next stitch *Work 1 hdc in each of the next 3 ch (there is a total of 5 hdc include the turn chain). In the next two chains, 2hdctog. Then 2hdctog again in the next two chains (1 stitch). Work 1 hdc in each of the next 3 ch, then work 2 hdc in next ch, and another 2 hdc in the next chain.

Repeat from * across to the last *ch*. Work 2 *hdc* into the top of the *ch* 2 turning chain from the previous row. *Ch* 2 and turn.

Repeat row 2 for the rest of the blanket until you reach your desired length.

Color changes: 3 rows of dark green (frosted pine), 1 row light green (smokey green) End with 3 rows of dark green.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
