123 Sedge Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

Supplies

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- H, 5 mm crochet hook
- <u>5, 3.75 mm crochet hook</u> for smaller wash cloth
- 1– 2.5 oz Lion Brand Re-up Cotton Yarn – in Confetti – I used all of it
- 1 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in denim any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx 2.5oz

Abbreviations – US Terms

- yo yarn over
- *sl* slip stitch
- *sc* single crochet
- *hdc* half double crochet
- **dc** double crochet stitch

You can make a larger or smaller <u>dishcloth</u> or a blanket by using an multiple of 3 for the chain.

Smaller wash cloth -

Approx. 9 in x 10.5 in (22 cm x 26 cm)

Chain 42

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, *hdc*, *dc*, skip 2 chains and in the next work *sc*, *hdc*, *dc*. Skip 2 chains and repeat "*sc*, *hdc*, *dc*" into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 *sc*. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: hdc and DC into the top of the sc you just made. Skip over the dc and hdc, *"sc, hdc, dc" into the sc*. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

You'll always be looking for the sc to do your "sc, hdc, dc" into.

Repeat row 2 until you have used all the yarn, 28 rows. Cut yarn, weave in ends.

Larger wash cloth - Approx. 11 in x 11 in (28 cm x 28 cm)

Chain 42

Follow as above until you have 27 rows.
