

## 123 Sedge Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">H, 5 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• <a href="#">5, 3.75 mm crochet hook</a> - for smaller wash cloth</li><li>• 1- 2.5 oz Lion Brand Re-up Cotton Yarn – in Confetti – I used all of it</li><li>• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in denim any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx 2.5oz</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>sl</b> – slip stitch</li><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>hdc</b> – half double crochet</li><li>• <b>dc</b> – double crochet stitch</li></ul>

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an multiple of 3 for the chain.

### Smaller wash cloth -

Approx. 9 in x 10.5 in (22 cm x 26 cm)

Chain 42

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, **hdc, dc**, skip 2 chains and in the next work **sc, hdc, dc**. Skip 2 chains and repeat “**sc, hdc, dc**” into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: **hdc** and DC into the top of the **sc** you just made. Skip over the **dc** and **hdc**, \***“sc, hdc, dc”** into the **sc**\*. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

You’ll always be looking for the **sc** to do your “**sc, hdc, dc**” into.

Repeat row 2 until you have used all the yarn, 28 rows. Cut yarn, weave in ends.

### Larger wash cloth - Approx. 11 in x 11 in (28 cm x 28 cm)

Chain 42

Follow as above until you have 27 rows.
