Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• F, 3.75 mm crochet hook• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Coral Seas Ombre any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo – yarn over</i>• <i>sl – slip stitch</i>• <i>sc – single crochet</i>• <i>hdc – half double crochet</i>

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an odd number for the chain.

Approx. 10 in x 10 in (25 cm x 25 cm)

Chain 41

Row 1: In 3rd chain from the hook, **sl** in the chain, then **hdc**. Alternate **sl**, **hdc**. Repeat across to the end. End with a **sl**. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: **sl** into the 2nd on top of the **hdc** from the row below. Alternate **sl**, **hdc**. Repeat across to the end. End with a **sl**. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 42 or the dishcloth is square. Cut yarn weave in ends.

You'll always be putting the slip stitch on top of the half double crochet from the row below and the half double crochet on top of the slip stitch from the row below.
