Dainty Dot Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- F/5, 3.75 mm crochet hook
- 4 4.2 oz balls of <u>Bernat Softee Baby</u> <u>Yarn Stripes in Sand and Pebbles Stripe</u> or 1148 yd or 16.8 oz of gauge 3 yarn

Abbreviations – US Terms

- sc single crochet
- *dc* double crochet
- *ebc* even berry crochet
- *ch* chain
- **YO** yarn over

special stitch -even berry crochet – yo insert your hook into the space, yo, pull through, yo, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, yo, insert your hook into the same designated space again, yo, pull through, yo, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

Approx. 33 in x 36 in (83 cm x 91 cm)

gauge: 1.75 in 1.75 in - 3 rows of double crochet by 7 stitches (4.445 cm)

Sand and Pebbles Stripe

Chain: 141

Row 1: **Dc** in 4th chain from the end. **dc** in the next chain and to the end. Chain 3 turn.

Row 2: sc in 1st stitch, *ebc in next stitch, sc in next stitch,* End with sc. Chain 3, turn.

Row 3: **Dc** in each stitch to the end. Chain 3, turn.

Row 4: **Dc** in each stitch to the end. Chain 3, turn.

Row 5: **Dc** in each stitch to the end. Chain 1, turn.

Row 6: sc in 1st stich, *ebc in next stitch, sc in next stitch,* End with sc. Chain 3, turn.

Row 7-9: **Dc** in each stitch to the end. Chain 3 turn. Row 9 chain 1, turn.

Row 10: sc in 1st stich, *ebc in next stitch, sc in next stitch,* End with sc. Chain 3, turn.

Repeat **Row 7-10** until you have rows. Ending with 1 row of double crochet. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry needle.
