

## Even Berry Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <b>H, 5 mm crochet hook</b></li><li>• 2 – 2.5 Lily Sugar n Cream in <b>yellow</b> and <b>hot orange</b> or any other worsted weight 100% cotton yarn approx 4 oz of each color.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>yo</i> – <i>yarn over</i></li><li>• <i>sl</i> – <i>slip stitch</i></li><li>• <i>sc</i> – <i>single crochet</i></li><li>• <i>ebc</i> – <i>even berry crochet stitch</i></li></ul>

**special stitch** -even berry crochet – *yo* insert your hook into the space, *yo*, pull through, *yo*, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, *yo*, insert your hook into the same designated space again, *yo*, pull through, *yo*, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

For the even berry stitch, you need a single crochet stitch between each of the even berry stitches. You also need to alternate with a row between each of the even berry rows otherwise the texture will not be on the same side.

You can make a larger or smaller dish cloth or a blanket by using an even number +1 for the chain.

Approx. 12.5 in x 12.5 in (33 cm x 33 cm)

Color A – Yellow - Chain 35

Row 1: *sc* in the 2nd chain from hook, *ebc*, then\* *sc* in next stitch, *ebc* in next\* then repeat \* until the end of the chain. End with a *sc*. Chain 1 turn (34 st)

Row 2: *sc* in the first *ebc* repeat until the end of the row chain 1 turn (34 st)

Row 3: Repeat row 1 & 2 until you have 18 rows. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry.

Border - Color B -Orange

Pull up a stitch on either the top of bottom, then single crochet around in each stitch. On the sides space the stitches evenly, 2 stitches for each *ebc* and 1 for *sc*. Crochet 3 single crochet in each corner. *Sl* and then chain 1. Do another row of single crochet. *Sl* to the first stitch.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy

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
