

Half Double Dish Cloth Pattern

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Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• F, 3.75 mm crochet hook• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in psychedelic any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx 2.1 oz•	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo – yarn over</i>• <i>sl – slip stitch</i>• <i>sc – single crochet</i>• <i>hdc – half double crochet</i>
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You can make a larger or smaller potholder by using any number of chains.

Approx. 10 in x 10 in (25 cm x 25 cm)

Chain 36

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, **sc**, in the next chain, **hdc**.
Alternate **sc**, **hdc**. Repeat across to the end. End with a **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: **hdc** into the top of the **sc** you just made. Alternate **hdc**, **sc**. Repeat across to the end. End with a **hdc**. Chain 1, turn.

Row 3: **sc** into the top of hdc you just made, in the next chain, **hdc**.
Alternate **sc**, **hdc**. Repeat across to the end. End with a **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

You'll always be putting the single crochet on top of the half double crochet from the row below and the half double crochet on top of the single crochet from the row below.

Repeat row 2-3 until you have 32 rows. Cut yarn, weave in ends.

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
