

## Chunky Herringbone Crochet Headband Pattern

<b>Supplies</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">N, 9 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 1 - Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick &amp; Quick Yarn 6 oz, <a href="#">Cranberry</a> gauge 6 yarn (approx. 3 oz or 53 yd of each color) or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn.</li></ul>	<b>Abbreviations – US Terms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>hhdc</b> – herringbone half double crochet</li></ul>

**special stitch** -herringbone half double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **Yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **Yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

You can make a larger or smaller headband using any number for the chain.

size adult -Approx. 22 in x 5 in (56 cm x 13 cm)

Chain 13

Row 1: In 3rd chain from the hook, **hhdc**. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: In the stitch next to the chain, **hhdc**. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 35 or the length you want. Whip stitch the two ends together. Cut and weave in ends.
