Crossed Double Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- N, 9 mm crochet hook
- 2–10.5 cakes of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn Dappled– <u>Wandering Blue</u> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (220 yd)

Abbreviations – US Terms

- *ch* chain
- *yo* yarn over
- *sc* single crochet
- **dc** double crochet

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special stitch: crossed double crochet, crochet a double crochet like normal and then go back one stitch and do another double crochet to make an x.

Gauge: 3 rows x 8 double crochet stitches = 4 in x 4 in (10.1 cm)

Approx. 30 in x 36 in (76 cm x 91 cm)

Chain 64

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an a multiple of 3 +5 for the chain.

Chain 65

Row 1: double crochet in the 4^h chain from the hook. Dc across to the end. Chain 4, turn.(chain will be dc and first chain)

Row 2:* skip 2 dc and dc in the 3rd. then go back one stitch and dc. Ch 1. *Repeat ** until the last 2 stitches of row. Chain 1 skip 1 stitch and dc in 2nd stitch. Chain 3, turn.

Row 3: dc across. Chain 4, turn.

Repeat row 2 -3 until you have 33 rows

Knot, cut end and weave ends with a tapestry needle.
