Gauge: 6 row x 8 stitches 4 in x 4 in (10 cm)

Approx. 30 in x 33 in (76 cm x 84 cm)

Chain 64

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an odd number +3 for the chain.

Row 1: **dc** in the 3 chain from hook. **sc**, Repeat **dc**, **sc** to the end. End with a **dc**. Chain 3, turn.

Row 2: **dc**, **sc** repeat to the end. End with a **dc**. Chain 3, turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have used both cakes of yarn. Finish with a complete row of the last color.

Knot, cut end and weave ends with a tapestry needle.
