 Scissors tapestry needle <u>N, 9 mm crochet hook</u> 2- 10.5 cakes of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn - <u>Above the Clouds</u> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (220 yd) 	Abbreviations – US Terms • ch – chain • yo – yarn over • sc – single crochet da double graphet
Sundy gauge of yurn (220 yu)	• <i>dc</i> – double crochet

Gauge: 6 row x 8 stitches 4 in x 4 in (10 cm)

Approx. 30 in x 33 in (76 cm x 84 cm)

Chain 64

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an odd number +3 for the chain.

Row 1: dc in the 3 chain from hook. sc, Repeat dc, sc to the end. End with a dc. Chain 3, turn.

Row 2: *dc*, *sc* repeat to the end. End with a *dc*. Chain 3, turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have used both cakes of yarn. Finish with a complete row of the last color.

Knot, cut end and weave ends with a tapestry needle.
