

## Gray & Green Easy Striped Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">N, 9 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 2- 10.5 cakes of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn - <a href="#">Sprouts</a> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (220 yd each)</li><li>•</li></ul>	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>ch</b> – chain</li><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>dc</b> – double crochet</li><li>• <b>dctog</b> – double crochet together</li></ul>

**special stitch**, double crochet together: **YO**, insert hook into first stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through drawing up three loops on hook, **yo**, pull through two loops, **yo**, insert hook into same stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through to draw up three loops on hook, **yo** and draw through 2 loops, **yo** and draw through last 3 loops.

Gauge: 28 in x 37 in (71 cm x 94 cm)

Approx. 6 stitches x 3 rows = 5.5 in x 5 in (14 cm x 12.7 cm)

*Chain 64*

Row 1: In 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook **sc**. \*Chain 1, skip one chain, **sc** in the next chain\*. Repeat\* until end. End with **sc**. Chain 3, turn.

Row 2: In 1<sup>st</sup> chain space of the row below, **dctog**. Chain 1. Skip one stitch and **dctog** in the next chain space\*. Repeat \* until one stitch left. **Dc** in the last stitch. Chain 2, turn.

Row 3: In the 1st chain space for the row below, **sc**. \*Chain 1. Skip 1 stitch, **sc** in the next chain space. \* Repeat \* until last stitch. End with a **sc** in the chain from of the row below.

Repeat Row 2-3 until you have used all of the yarn and ended with a complete row of color. 47 rows.

Knot, cut end and weave ends with a tapestry needle.
