

Herringbone Stripe Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• N, 9 mm crochet hook• 2- 10.5 cakes of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn - Coral Bells or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (220 yd)• 1 - 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn - White or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (220yd) approx. 6.5 oz	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch - chain• yo – yarn over• sc – single crochet• hdbc – herringbone double crochet
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special stitch -herringbone double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **yo** pull through 1 loop on the hook, **yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

Note: I found the first and last color were not very long. You might want to cut the first color off and start with the 2nd.

Gauge: 4 rows x 5 hdbh + ch = 4 in x 4 in (10 cm)

Approx. 37 in x 50 in (border 2 1/2 in) 94 cm x 127 cm (border 6.35 cm)

Chain 76

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an odd number +3 for the chain.

Row 1: **hdbc** in the 3 chain from hook. Chain 1, skip 1 stitch. **hdbc**, chain 1, skip 1 stitch. Repeat to the end. End with a **hdbc**. Chain 4, turn. (chain 4 is the first **hdbc** and the first chain.

Row 2: Skip one stitch, **hdbc**. *Chain 1, skip 1 stitch, **hdbc*** Repeat * to end. End with a **hdbc**. Chain 4, turn. (chain 4 is the first **hdbc** and the first chain.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 40 rows.

Border – coral bells, then white

Pull up a loop at any corner in coral bells. **sc** around evenly. Do 4 **sc** in each corner, 2 on each side of the corner. I did 2 single crochet for each double herringbone crochet stitch when doing the sides and 1 for the top of each row. If it is rippling try just 2 stitches.

2nd row change to white and do 4 more rows of single crochet. Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Enjoy.
