## Herringbone Half Double Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul> <li>Scissors</li> <li>tapestry needle</li> <li><u>F, 3.75 mm crochet hook</u></li> <li>1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in <u>Pebble</u> <u>Beach Ombre</u> any other worsted weight cotton yarn</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>yo – yarn over</li> <li>hhdc – herringbone half double crochet</li> </ul>

**special stitch** -herringbone half double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. *Yo* and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. *Yo*, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

You can make a larger or smaller <u>dishcloth</u> or a blanket by using an any number for the chain.

Chain 41

Row 1: In 3rd chain from the hook, *hhdc*. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Row 3: In the stitch next to the chain, *hhdc*. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 42 or the dishcloth is square. Cut yarn weave in ends.

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
