

Herringbone Half Double Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• F, 3.75 mm crochet hook• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Pebble Beach Ombre any other worsted weight cotton yarn	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo – yarn over</i>• <i>hhdc – herringbone half double crochet</i>
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special stitch -herringbone half double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. *Yo* and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. *Yo*, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an any number for the chain.

Approx. 11 in x 11 in (28 cm x 28 cm)

Chain 41

Row 1: In 3rd chain from the hook, *hhdc*. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Row 3: In the stitch next to the chain, *hhdc*. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 42 or the dishcloth is square. Cut yarn weave in ends.

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
