

## Stripe Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">H, 5 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 4 – 5 oz Bernat Pop in <a href="#">pop art</a> any other worsted weight yarn approx 20 oz</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>hdc</b> – half double crochet</li><li>• <b>dc</b> – double crochet stitch</li></ul>

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using a multiple of 3 for the chain.

Approx. 32 in x 37 in (81 cm x 94 cm)

Gauge: 8 stitch groups x 9 rows approx. 4 in x 4 in (10 cm)

Chain 114

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, **hdc, dc**, skip 2 chains and in the next work **sc, hdc, dc**. Skip 2 chains and repeat “**sc, hdc, dc**” into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 **sc**. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: **hdc** and DC into the top of the **sc** you just made. Skip over the **dc** and **hdc**, \***“sc, hdc, dc”** into the **sc**\*. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

You’ll always be looking for the **sc** to do your “**sc, hdc, dc**” into.

Repeat row 2 until you have used all the yarn, 92 rows. End with a completer row of the last color. Cut yarn, weave in ends.

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
