Stripe Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
 Scissors tapestry needle <u>H, 5 mm crochet hook</u> 4 - 5 oz Bernat Pop in <u>pop art</u> any other worsted weight yarn approx 20 oz 	 yo - yarn over sc - single crochet hdc - half double crochet dc - double crochet stitch

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using a multiple of 3 for the chain.

Approx. 32 in x 37 in (81 cm x 94 cm)

Gauge: 8 stitch groups x 9 rows approx. 4 in x 4 in (10 cm)

Chain 114

Row 1: In 2nd chain from the hook, *hdc*, *dc*, skip 2 chains and in the next work *sc*, *hdc*, *dc*. Skip 2 chains and repeat "*sc*, *hdc*, *dc*" into the next space. Repeat across to the end and there is one chain left. Work 1 *sc*. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: *hdc* and DC into the top of the *sc* you just made. Skip over the *dc* and *hdc*, *"*sc*, *hdc*, *dc*" into the *sc**. Repeat the pattern across ending the last stitch with one single crochet. Chain 1, turn.

You'll always be looking for the sc to do your "sc, hdc, dc" into.

Repeat row 2 until you have used all the yarn, 92 rows. End with a completer row of the last color. Cut yarn, weave in ends.
