

Crunch Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• F, 3.75 mm crochet hook• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Strawberry any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo – yarn over</i>• <i>sl – slip stitch</i>• <i>sc – single crochet</i>• <i>hdc – half double crochet</i>
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You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an odd number for the chain.

Approx. 9.5 in x 9.5 in (24 cm x 24 cm)

Chain 34

Row 1: *sl* in the 2nd chain from the hook, in the next stitch *hdc*, *sl* in the next stitch, repeat until the end of the row ending with a *sl*. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: *sl* in the 1st stitch, then *hdc* in the next, alternating *sl*, *hdc* until the end of the row always end with *sl*. Chain 1, turn. (*sl* is always on top of the *sl* and *hdc* in always on top of *hdc*)

Repeat Row 2 until you have 40 or the dishcloth is square. Cut yarn weave in ends.

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
