

Blue Stripe Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• 4.5 mm crochet hook• 2- 3.5 oz Lion Brand Yarn Feels Like Butta Yarn, Dusty Blue• 1- 3.5 oz Lion Brand Yarn Feels Like Butta Yarn, Ice• 1- 3.5 oz Lion Brand Yarn Feels Like Butta Yarn, Pale Gray• 1- 3.5 oz Lion Brand Yarn Feels Like Butta Yarn, Charcoal	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch – chain• yo – yarn over• hdc – half double crochet
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Half double crochet- Yo and insert the crochet hook into the stitch. **Yo** again and pull the yarn through the stitch. You should now have three loops on the hook. **Yo** one more time and pull the yarn through all three loops.

Gauge: 3 in x 3 in - 7 rows x 10 stitches (8 cm)

Approx. 32 in x 38 in (81 cm x 97 cm)

Chain 98

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using a chain in any chain

Row 1: **hdc** in the 3rd chain from the hook and in each stitch across. **Ch 2** and turn.

Row 2: **hdc** in the first stitch and all they way across. **ch 2** and turn.

Repeat Row 2, following the color pattern below.

7 rows of dusty blue, 2 rows of charcoal, 7 rows of dusty blue, 2 rows of ice, 7 rows of charcoal, 2 rows of dusty blue, 7 rows of charcoal, 2 rows of pale gray, 7 rows of ice, 2 rows of dusty blue, 7 rows of ice, 2 rows of charcoal, 7 rows of dusty blue, 2 rows of pale gray, 7 rows of dusty blue, 2 rows of ice, 7 rows of pale gray, 2 rows of dusty blue, 7 rows of pale gray

Knot, cut end and weave ends with a tapestry needle.
