Ocean Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
 Scissors tapestry needle <u>N, 9 mm crochet hook</u> 2- 10.5 balls of <u>Bernat Blanket Yarn in</u> <u>Ocean Shades</u> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (approx. 440 yd) 	 <i>sl</i> - slip stitch <i>sc</i> - single crochet <i>dc</i> - double crochet <i>ch</i> - chain <i>sk</i> - skip <i>sp</i> - space <i>scbl</i> - single crochet in back loop only <i>dcbl</i> - double crochet in back loop only

special stitch - single and double crochet in back loop only - do the single crochet like your normally would but only put the hook in the back loop (the loop the farthest away from you).

Approx. 35 in x 38 in (88 cm x 96 cm)

gauge: 4 in x 4 in = 7 stitches by 4 rows

Chain 64

Row 1: sc in the 2nd chain from hook repeat until the end of the chain, chain 3 turn (63 st)

Row 2: *dcbl* in the first *sc* repeat until the end of the chain, chain 1 turn (63 st)

Row 3: *scbl* in each of the stitch across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 4: Repeat row 2 & 3 until you have 36 rows.

Border - **Row 1**: Do not tie off. *ch* 1, turn. *sc* in each stitch around entire blanket. On the sides, single crochet evenly. I did 1 single crochet in the single crochet row and 3 in the double crochet row. Do 2 sc in the stitches on either side of the corner.

Row 2: *sl* to the first chain. *ch* 1, *sc* in each stitch around. Doing 2 *sc* in the stitches on either side of the corner. *sl* to the first *sc*.

Knot and weave in ends.

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
