

Chunky Herringbone Crochet Cowl Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• N, 9 mm crochet hook• 1 ball of Lion Brand Wool-Ease Yarn Thick & Quick in Cranberry or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn, approx. 6 oz or 106 yd. (170 g or 97 m)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• yo – yarn over• hhdc – herringbone half double crochet

Gauge: hhdc crochet stitches 6 x 3 rows = 2.5 in x 2.5 in (6 cm x 6 cm)

special stitch -herringbone half double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **Yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **Yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

You can make a larger or smaller cowl using any number for the chain.

Chain 60

Row 1: In 3rd chain from the hook, **hhdc**. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: In the stitch next to the chain, **hhdc**. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 8 or the length you want. Whip stitch the two ends together. Cut and weave in ends.

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
