

Textured Gray Stripe Chunky Throw Blanket Crochet Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• N, 9 mm crochet hook• 3 – 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn – Silver Steel or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (660yd)• 2- 10.5 ball Bernat Blanket Yarn – Dark Gray or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (440 yd)	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>sc</i> – single crochet• <i>dc</i> – double crochet• <i>ebc</i> – even berry crochet• <i>ch</i>– chain• <i>YO</i> – yarn over
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special stitch -even berry crochet – *yo* insert your hook into the space, *yo*, pull through, *yo*, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, *yo*, insert your hook into the same designated space again, *yo*, pull through, *yo*, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

Approx. 42 in x 58 in (107 cm x 147 cm)

Color A – Silver Steel

Chain 85

Row 1: *Dc* in 4th chain from the end. *dc* in the next chain and to the end. Chain 3 turn.

Row 2: *Dc* in each stitch to the end. Chain 3 turn.

Row 3: *Dc* in each stitch to the end. Chain 1 turn. Tie off.

Color B - Dark Gray

Row 4: *sc* in each stitch until the end of the row. Chain 1 turn.

Row 5: *sc* in 1st stich, **ebc* in next stitch, *sc* in next stitch,* End with *sc*. Chain 1 turn.

Row 6: *sc* in each stitch until the end of the row. Chain 3 turn. Tie off.

Repeat **Row 2**, 3 times ending with a chain 1.

Then repeat **Row 4-5**. Keep alternating the last 2 steps until you have 66 rows.

Ending with 3 rows of double crochet. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry needle.
