Pink Cloud Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- N, 9 mm crochet hook
- 2 10.5 ball of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn - <u>Pink Dreams</u> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (15. 5 oz or 336 yd
- 1 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn <u>White</u> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (110 yd)

Abbreviations – US Terms

- *sc* single crochet
- *hdc* double crochet
- *tr* triple crochet
- *ch* chain
- sk skip
- *sp* space

triple crochet stitch – here is a written example and a video from Lion Brand.

Gauge: 4.25 in x 4.25 in = 4 rows of hdc x 7 hdc stiches (10.795 cm)

Approx. 30 in x 36 in (76 cm x 92 cm)

Chain 61

Color A – Pink Dreams

Row 1: *hdc* in the 2nd chain from hook repeat until the end of the chain, chain 2 turn (59 st)

Row 2: *hdc* in the first *hdc* repeat until the end of the chain, chain 2 turn (59 st)

Row 3-7: Repeat row 2 until you have 7 rows. Chain 1 on row 7 and turn. (59 st)

On the last stitch before you change colors, wrap over with the **new color** and finish normally and then chain one with the new color and continue the pattern. Do this each time you change colors.

Color B - White

Row 8: *3 sc, 3 tr*, repeat to end last stitch is a sc. Chain 1 and turn (59 st)

Row 9: sc, repeat to the end. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 10:* 3 tr, 3 sc*, repeat to end last stitch is a sc. Chain 2 and turn (59 st)

Row 11-17: Repeat row 2 until you have 7 rows. Chain 1 on row 17 and turn. (59 st)

Row 18-20: Repeat rows 8-10.

Row 21-27: Repeat row 2 until you have 7 rows. Chain 1 on row 27 and turn. (59 st)

Row 28-30: Repeat rows 8-10.

Row 31-33: Repeat row 2 until you have 7 rows. Chain 1 on row 33 and turn. (59 st)

Row 34-40: Repeat rows 8-10.

Row 41-47: Repeat row 2 until you have 7 rows. (59 st)

Knot and weave in ends.

To enlarge blanket, the chain needs to be a multiple of 3 + 4. Like 90 = 4. For the stripes keep repeating the pink and white and end on a pink stripe. Enjoy your pink clouds baby blanket.
