You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an odd number for the chain.

Approx. 37 x 46

Chain 121

Row 1: **sc** in the 2nd chain from hook, until the end of the chain. Chain 1 turn (36 st)

Row 2: **dc** in the first **sc**, *skip a stitch, **sc**, **dc**, in the next stitch* repeat ** until the end of the row. End with 1 **sc**. Chain 1 turn (36 st)

Row 3: Repeat row 2 until you have **16 rows** of Color A plus the row of single crochet (17 total). Then **4 rows** of Color B, **16 rows** of Color A, **4 rows** of Color B, **16 rows** of Color A, **4 rows** of Color B, **16 rows** of color A, **4 rows** of Color B, **16 rows** of Color A, **4 rows** of Color B, **16 rows** of color A. Last row is a row of single crochet. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry needle.

There are 6 blocks of the Color A alternated with 5 blocks of the Color B.
