Vintage White Chunky Chevron Crochet Blanket Pattern

Abbreviations – US Terms

- yo yarn over
- *sc* single crochet
- sc2tog single crochet crochet stitch decrease
- dc3tog double crochet crochet stitch bobble

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- N, 9 mm crochet hook
- 7 10.5 oz (300 g) ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn – <u>Vintage White</u> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (1540yd or 1400 m)

special stitch - single crochet decrease stitch - insert your hook into the first chain, pull up a loop, insert your hook into the next chain, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through all loops on your hook

special stitch - 3 double together crochet stitch bobble -*yo, insert hook, pull up a loop, yo, pull through two loops. Repeat from * 2 more times. Then yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook.

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using To make your blanket bigger or smaller, any multiple of 33 plus 3. Multiply the number of peaks you want by 33, then add 3.

Gauge: 4 rows x 5 stitches - 2.5 in x 2.5 in (6 cm)

Approx. size: 56 in x 66 in (142 cm x 168)

Chain: 136

Row 1 In the 2^{nd} chain from the hook and the next chain, sc2tog. * sc in the next 15 chains, work 3 sc into the next chain, sc in the next 15 chains, skip 2 chains. repeat * After you have worked the last 13 chains, you should have two extra. sc2tog these last two stitches. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: *sc2tog* *Then work 15 *sc*, work 3 *sc* into the next stitch (this should be the middle stitch of the 3 *sc* you did in the row before), work 15 *sc*, skip two stitches at the bottom for the valley, and repeat *. After you have worked the last 15 chains, *sc2tog* these last two stitches. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: Repeat row 2

Row 4: sc2tog *Then work 4 sc, 1 dc3tog, 2 sc work, 1 dc3tog, 2 sc, 1 dc3tog, 4 sc. Then 3 sc into the next stitch (this should be the middle stitch of the 3 sc you did in the row before), work 4 sc, 1 dc3tog, 2 sc work, 1 dc3tog, 2 sc, 1 dc3tog, 4 sc., skip two stitches at the bottom for the valley, and repeat *. After you have worked the last 15 stitches, sc2tog these last two stitches. Chain 1 and turn.

For the rest of the blanket repeat 3 rows of Row 2 and 1 Row 4 until you have 79 rows. You end with 3 rows or Row 2 (single crochet).

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy your chunky chevron crochet blanket.
