## Crunch Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul> <li>Scissors</li> <li>tapestry needle</li> <li>H/8 5 mm Crochet Hook</li> <li>1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in <u>Coral</u> <u>Seas Ombre</u> any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>yo - yarn over</li> <li>ch- chain</li> <li>sc - single crochet</li> <li>st- stitch</li> </ul>

**Special Stitch - Bean Stitch** - Insert hook in next *st*, *yo* and pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), *yo* in same stitch and pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), *yo* in same stitch once more and pull up a loop (6 loops on hook), *yo* and pull through all 6 loops on hook, *ch* 1 to complete stitch. Every bean *s*titch is finished with a chain 1.

You can make a larger or smaller <u>dishcloth</u> or a blanket by using an even number for the chain.

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Approx. 9 1/2 in x 9 1/2 in (24 cm)

Chain 34

Row 1: Sc 2nd chain from hook. Sc in each stitch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: sc in first st, \*skip next st, bean st in next st; rep from \* until 2 sts left, skip next st, sc in last st. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: sc in first st, bean stitch in ch-1 sp of each bean st across, sc in last sc. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 25 or until the dishcloth is square. The last row is single crochet, one in each stitch across. Cut yarn weave in ends.

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
