

Berry Chunky Crochet Scarf Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• K – 6.5 mm crochet hook• 2– Caron Chunky Cakes in Rice Pudding any other super bulky gauge 6 yarn approx. 20 oz. or 600 yd.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• yo – yarn over• sc – single crochet• hdc – half double crochet• ebc – even berry crochet• ch– chain• st - stitch

special stitch -even berry crochet – **yo** insert your hook into the space, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, **yo**, insert your hook into the same designated space again, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an even number for the chain. The turning chain will count as the first stitch of each new row.

Approx. 12 in x 75 in (30 cm x 191 cm)

Chain 26

Row 1: **sc** in the 2nd chain from hook. ***ebc** in next stitch, **sc** in next stitch,* End with **sc**. Chain 2 turn.

Row 2: **hdc** in the 2nd **st**, and across the row. Chain 2 turn.

Row 3: Repeat row 2

Row 4: **hdc** in the 2nd **st**, and across the row. Chain 1 turn.

Row 5: ***ebc** in 1st stitch, **sc** in next stitch,* End with **sc**. Chain 2 turn.

Row 6 -: Repeat Row 2-5 ending with a row of ebc.

Tie and cut ends. Weave in all yarn ends. You can increase the length of the scarf by adding more repeats of Row 6.
