

Berry Chunky Crochet Scarf Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• K – 6.5 mm crochet hook• 2– Caron Chunky Cakes in Rice Pudding any other super bulky gauge 6 yarn approx. 20 oz. or 600 yd.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• yo – yarn over• hhc – herringbone half double crochet• ch– chain• st – stitch

special stitch -herringbone stitch half double crochet – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

You can make a longer or shorter scarf using any number for the chain.

The chain count is for lengthwise. You will want to test the length after you have done a few rows to make sure the scarf is your desired length.

Approx. 11.5 in x 80 in (30 cm x 203 cm)

Chain 179

Row 1: In 3rd chain from the hook, **hhdc**. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: In the stitch next to the chain, **hhdc**. Repeat across to the end. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 23 or the width you want.

Tie and cut ends. Weave in all yarn ends. Match the two short ends together and whip stitch. You can increase the width of the scarf by adding more rows.

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
