

Crossed Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H/8 5 mm Crochet Hook• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Mistletoe any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx• 1- 4 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Red	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• yo – yarn over• ch– chain• dc – double crochet• st– stitch

For the **crossed double stitch**, you skip one stitch and double crochet in the next. Then you go back and double crochet in the stitch you skipped.

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an odd number + 3 for the chain. Turning chain counts as first stitch of the row.

Approx. 12 in x 12 in (30 cm)

Chain 38

Row 1: *dc* 4th chain from hook. *dc* in each stitch across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: *dc* in the 3rd *st*, go back 1 *st*, *dc*; *skip 1 *st*, *dc* in next, go back to skipped *st*, *dc** rep from * until 1 *st* left, *dc* in last *st*. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 3: *dc* in 2nd *st* and across. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 4: Repeat Row 3

Row 5: Repeat Row 2 (crossed double stitch)

Repeat 2 rows of double crochet and 1 row of crossed double until you have 21 rows ending with 1 row of double crochet after 1 row of crossed double crochet.

Version 1 color changes: Alternate 3 rows of red with 3 rows of mistletoe

Version 2 color changes: All rows of double crochet are red. All rows of crossed double crochet are mistletoe.

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in ends, using a tapestry needle.
