

## Men's Ribbed Crochet Scarf Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">H, 5 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 1– 9 oz (255 g) – <a href="#">Premier® Everyday Bobbin Yarn Serious Gray</a>– 543 yd -I used all of it or any worsted weight gauge 4 yarn</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>hdc</b> – half double crochet</li><li>• <b>bldc</b> - double crochet in the back loop only</li><li>• <b>blhdc</b> - half double crochet in the back loop only</li></ul>

You can make a larger or smaller men's crochet scarf pattern or a blanket by using any number for the chain. The turning chain does not count as a stitch.

I made the scarf lengthwise. If you want to make it longer you will need more of the yarn. You will want to chain and check the length. If you want it longer, increase the chain by any number.

Gauge: 2.5 in x 2.5 in (7.6 cm) = 6 rows x 9 stitches

Approx. 8.5 in x 75 in (22 cm x 191 cm)

**Chain 240**

Row 1: In 3rd chain from the hook, **hdc** and repeat in each stitch to the end of the row. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: In 1st stitch, **bldc** repeat to the end of the row, Chain 2, turn.

Row 3: In 1st stitch, **blhdc** repeat to the end of the row, Chain 3, turn.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you have used all the yarn, 6 rows of each color. Knot, cut ends, and weave ends in. Enjoy your men's crochet scarf.

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
