

## Pink Lemonade Throw Blanket Crochet Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">N, 9 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 3 – 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn – <a href="#">Raspberry Kisses</a> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (660yd)</li><li>• 2- 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn – <a href="#">Buttercup</a> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (440 yd)</li><li>• 1- 10.5 ball Bernat Blanket Yarn – White or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (220 yd)</li></ul>	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>dc</b> – double crochet</li><li>• <b>ebc</b> – even berry crochet</li><li>• <b>ch</b>– chain</li><li>• <b>YO</b> – yarn over</li></ul>

**special stitch** -even berry crochet – **yo** insert your hook into the space, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, **yo**, insert your hook into the same designated space again, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

For the even berry stitch, you need a single crochet stitch between each of the even berry stitches. You also need to alternate with a row between each of the even berry rows otherwise the texture will not be on the same side.

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an odd number for the chain.

Approx. crochet blanket size: 45 in x 53 in (114 cm x 135 cm)

### Color A –Pink

Chain 89

Row 1: **sc** in the 2nd chain and each **ch** until the end of the row. Chain 1 turn.

Row 2: **sc** in 1st stich, \***ebc** in next stitch, **sc** in next stitch,\* End with **sc**. Chain 1 turn.

Row 3: **sc** in each stitch until the end of the row. Chain 1 turn.

Repeat **Row 2-3**. 102 rows in total. Color changes as follows 15 rows of pink, 3 rows of white, 15 rows of yellow, 3 rows of white, 15 rows of pink, 3 rows of white, 15 rows of yellow, 3 rows of white, 15 rows of pink

Ending with 1 row of single crochet. Tie and cut off. Weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Enjoy your chunky throw blanket.
