## Ribbed Bulky Yarn Hat Pattern

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## **Supplies**

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- K 6.5 mm crochet hook
- 1- Caron Chunky Cakes in <u>Rice</u>
  <u>Pudding</u> any other super bulky gauge 6
  yarn approx. 10 oz. or 300 yd.
- 1- Lion Brand Thick & Quick in Cranberry 6 oz or 106 yd (170 g 97 m)
- optional medium gray wolf and black pompoms.

## Abbreviations – US Terms

- yo yarn over
- sc single crochet stitch
- hdc half double crochet
- ch- chain
- st stitch

You can decrease the size by less rows and stitches. The turning chain does not count as a stitch. The first stitch of every row goes in the same one as the turning chain.

Approx. size: women's large - gray hat 9 in x 11 in (23 cm x 28 cm) red hat 10 in x 11 in (25 cm x 28 cm)

Chain 27

**Row 1:** 2nd chain from the hook, work one *hdc*, repeat until you have 20 *st. sc* in the next 5 *st*. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: sc in 1st 5 st. hdc in the next 20 st. ch 2 and turn.

Row 3: hdc in 1st 20 stitches. sc in next 5 st. ch 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 2-3 until you have 35 rows. Cut yarn weave in ends. Fold the hat in half and whip stitch or slip stitch the short side.

For the red hat, I did 28 rows.

**To Finish Hat** Next, cut off a piece of yarn to gather the end where the single crochets are. At the top edge put thread the yarn in and out through each row around. Gather by pulling the ends. Knot and weave in all ends. Attach a pompom to finish the hat. I used medium gray wolf and black pompoms.

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
