

## Moss stitch Crochet Cowl Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• K - 6.5 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 1 – Caron Chunky Cakes in <a href="#">Blue Moon</a> any other super bulky gauge 6 yarn approx 5 oz per cowl</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>yo – yarn over</i></li><li>• <i>ch– chain stitch</i></li><li>• <i>sc – single crochet</i></li><li>• <i>sk– skip stitch</i></li></ul>

Gauge: 10 row x 10 stitches = 3.5 in x 3.5 in (9 cm)

Size: Adult women approx. 26 in x 7.5 in (66 cm x 19 cm) child approx. 20 in x 3.5 (56 cm x 9 cm)

You can make a larger or smaller cowl an even number for the chain.

Chain 74 (child 50)

Row 1: *sc* in the 4<sup>th</sup> chain from the hook, 1 *ch*, *sk* the next stitch, *sc* in the next stitch. Repeat until the end of the row ending with a *sc* in the last chain. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: *sc* in the chain space from the row below. Then \**ch* 1, *sk* 1 *sc*, *sc* in next *ch* 1 space\*. Repeat from \* until the end of the row. The last *sc* is worked into the space between the *ch* 2 turning chain and *sc* from the row before. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 22 rows. Fold rectangle in half and whip stitch the short side. Cut yarn weave in ends. Enjoy your crochet moss stitch crocheted cowl. (11 rows for child size)
