

Striped Large Wool Crochet Blanket Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• N, 9 mm crochet hook• 10 - 5 oz (140 g) Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn – Dusk or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn 87 yard ea• 6 - 6 oz (179 g) Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn – Glacier or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn 106 yd ea• 6 - 6 oz (179 g) Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn – Navy or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn 106 yd ea.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch – chain• yo – yarn over• sc - single crochet• dc – double crochet• fpdc– double crochet front post• bpdc – double crochet back post• fpsc - single crochet front post• fpbc - single crochet back post

front post single crochet stitch - insert the hook behind the post from the front across the post and through the other side, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook. For more info [here](#), from yarnspirations.com.

back post single crochet stitch - insert the hook behind the post from the front across the post and through the other side, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook. For more info [here](#), from yarnspirations.com.

front post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front across the post and through the other side, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info [here](#), from yarnspirations.com.

back post double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert the hook from the back of the post, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info [here](#), from yarnspirations.com.

To make the blanket larger or smaller use a multiple of 4 plus 3 for the chain. The turning chain counts as the first stitch of the row. If wanted to make a 50 x 64 blanket you would want to chain 103.

Approx. size of throw blanket: 44 in x 64 in (112 cm x 163 cm)

Gauge: 8 dc stitch x 4 row of dc plus 1 row of sc = 4 in (10.16 cm)

Chain 87

Color A - Dusk

Row 1: *Dc* in the 4th chain from the hook. *Dc* in the next chain and to the end of the row. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *Dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **bpdc* in the next stitch. *Dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 1 and turn.

Color B - Navy

Row 3: Turning chain counts as first *sc*. *sc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **fpdc* in the next stitch. *sc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *sc*. (for 4 *sc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Color C- Glacier

Row 4: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *Dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **bpdc* in the next stitch. *Dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Row 5: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **fpdc* in the next stitch. *dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 1 and turn.

Color B- Navy

Row 6: Turning chain counts as first *sc*. *sc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **bpsc* in the next stitch. *sc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *sc*. (for 4 *sc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Color A - Dusk

Row 7: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *Dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **fpdc* in the next stitch. *Dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Row 8: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **bpdc* in the next stitch. *dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 1 and turn.

Color C - Glacier

Row 9: Turning chain counts as first *sc*. *sc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **fp^{sc}* in the next stitch. *sc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *sc*. (for 4 *sc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Color B - Navy

Row 10: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *Dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **bp^{dc}* in the next stitch. *Dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Row 11: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **fp^{dc}* in the next stitch. *dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 1 and turn.

Color C - Glacier

Row 12: Turning chain counts as first *sc*. *sc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **bp^{sc}* in the next stitch. *sc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *sc*. (for 4 *sc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Color A Dusk

Row 13: Turning chain counts as first *dc*. *Dc* in the 2nd stitch and the following 2 stitches, **fp^{dc}* in the next stitch. *Dc* in the next 3 stitches*. Repeat** until the end of the row. Your last stitch will be a *dc*. (for 4 *dc* in a row) Chain 3 and turn.

Row 14-24: Repeat rows 2-12.

Repeat rows 13 and 2-12 until you have 98 rows or you run out of yarn ending on a complete row of the same color. There are 8 repeats of the color combos plus 2 more rows of the dusk. Cut ends and weave in ends.

The repeat is 2 rows of double crochet alternating front and back post so the post shows all on the same side. then one row of single crochet.
