

## Easy Peachy Crochet Baby Blanket With Super Bulky Yarn

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">N, 9 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 1- 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn – <a href="#">Sweetie Coral</a> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (660yd)</li><li>• 1- 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn – Baby Pink or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (440 yd)</li><li>• 1- 10.5 ball Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn – White or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn (220 yd)</li></ul>	<p>Abbreviations – US Terms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>sc</b> – single crochet</li><li>• <b>ebc</b> – even berry crochet</li><li>• <b>ch</b>– chain</li><li>• <b>YO</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>hhdc</b>- herringbone half double crochet</li></ul>
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**special stitch** -even berry crochet – **yo** insert your hook into the space, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, **yo**, insert your hook into the same designated space again, **yo**, pull through, **yo**, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook.

**special stitch** -herringbone half double crochet stitch – yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch. **Yo** and pull back through the stitch and the next loop on the hook. **Yo**, pull through remaining two loops on the hook.

For the even berry stitch, you need a single crochet stitch between each of the even berry stitches. You also need to alternate with a row between each of the even berry rows otherwise the texture will not be on the same side.

You can make a larger or smaller blanket by using an odd number for the chain.

Approx. crochet blanket size: 32 in x 36 in (81 cm x 91 cm)

Gauge: 4 in x 4 in = 9 hhdc stitches x 6 rows (10.16 cm)

*Chain 65 in color A*

Row 1: single crochet in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook and in each chain until the end of the row. Chain 1.

Row 2: ebc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch. Sc in the next stich. \*ebc in the next st, sc in the next\* Repeat \*\* until the end of the row ending with sc. Chain 1 and turn.

Rows 3-9: Repeat row 2 until you have 9 rows. On last row, change to color B & chain 2 and turn.

Rows 10-18: With color B *hhdc* in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch and in each stitch until the end of the row. Chain 2 and turn. On last row, change color to color C & chain 1 and turn.

Row 19-27: With color C, repeat row 2 until you have 9 rows. On last row, change to color B & chain 2 and turn.

Rows 28-36: With color B, *hhdc* in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch and in each stitch until the end of the row. Chain 2 and turn. On last row, change color to color C & chain 1 and turn.

Row 37-45: With color C, repeat row 2 until you have 9 rows. On last row, change to color A & chain 2 and turn.

Row 46-54: With color A, *hhdc* in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch and in each stitch until the end of the row.

Cut end and knot. Weave in all ends.
