

# Striped Large Chunky Crochet Blanket Pattern for Beginner s

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">N, 9 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 11- 5 oz (140 g) Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick &amp; Quick Yarn – <a href="#">River Run</a> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn 87 yard ea</li><li>• 6- 5 oz (140 g) Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick &amp; Quick Yarn – <a href="#">Licorice</a> or any super bulky gauge 6 yarn 87 yd ea</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>ch</b> – chain</li><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>sc</b> - single crochet</li></ul>

To make the blanket larger or smaller use an even number.

Approx. 48 in x 60 in without border (91 cm x 132 cm) Border 4 in (10.16 cm) Total: 56 in x 68 in (142 cm x 173 cm) Gauge: 10 stitches by 10 rows = 4 in

Chain 128

Row 1: **sc** in the 4<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 **ch**, **sk** the next stitch, **sc** in the next stitch. Repeat until the end of the row ending with a **sc** in the last chain. Chain 2, turn.

Row 2: **sc** in the chain space from the row below. Then \***ch** 1, **sk** 1 **sc**, **sc** in next **ch** 1 space\*. Repeat from \* until the end of the row. The last **sc** is worked into the space between the **ch** 2 turning chain and **sc** from the row before. Chain 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 112 rows. Color changes: 16 rows of River run, 9rows of Licorice, 16 rows of River Run, 9 rows of Licorice, 16 row of River Run, 9 rows of Licorice, 16 rows of River Run.

Border

Round 1: Turn and chain 2. \***sc**. Ch1, **sc** 1\* Repeat \*\* until in of round Put [1 **sc**, 1 **ch**, 1 **sc**] on each corner. Put 1 **sc** in each row down the sides.

Round 2: Continue \***sc**. Ch1, **sc** 1\* Repeat \*\* until in of round Put [1 **sc**, 1 **ch**, 1 **sc**] on each corner.

Repeat round 2 in you have 10 rounds. 7- River Run & 3 -Licorice

Cut end and knot. Weave in ends. Enjoy your crocheted moss stitch chunky throw.
