

Cluster V Double Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H/8 5 mm Crochet Hook• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Soleil Ombre or any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• yo – yarn over• ch– chain• dc2tog– double crochet 2 together• st– stitch

Special stitch: dc2tog - Double crochet 2 together - **YO**, insert hook into first stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through drawing up three loops on hook, **yo**, pull through two loops, **yo**, insert hook into same stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through to draw up three loops on hook, yo and draw through 2 loops, yo and draw through last 3 loops.

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using a multiple of 3 + 1 for the chain. Turning chain counts as first stitch of the row.

Chain 37

Row 1: (dc2tog, ch 1, dc2tog) in 5th ch from hook. *Skip 2 chs, (dc2tog, ch 1, dc2tog) in next. Repeat from * across until 2 chs remain. Skip 1 ch. Dc in last. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: (dc2tog, ch 1, dc2tog) in each ch 1 space across. Dc in last stitch. Chain 3 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 15 rows or the dishcloth is square. Cut and knot yarn. Weave in ends, using a tapestry needle.
