

## Lilac Fade Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• <a href="#">N, 9 mm crochet hook</a></li><li>• 3– 10.5 cakes of Bernat Baby Blanket Yarn Dappled– <a href="#">Misty Jungle Green</a> or any super bulky</li></ul>	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>ch</b> – chain</li><li>• <b>dc</b> – double crochet</li><li>• dc2tog - double crochet 2 together</li></ul>
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### Abbreviations – US Term

- **ch** – chain
- **dc** – double crochet
- dc2tog - double crochet 2 together

**special stitch**, double crochet together: **YO**, insert hook into first stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through drawing up three loops on hook, **yo**, pull through two loops, **yo**, insert hook into same stitch from row below, **yo** and pull through to draw up three loops on hook, **yo** and draw through 2 loops, **yo** and draw through last 3 loops.

**Cluster V-Stitch:** Dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog all in the same space

To make this blanket bigger or smaller chain a multiple of 3+1. The turning chain counts as the first stitch.

Approx. size of blanket: 38 in x 44 in (97 cm x 112 cm)

Gauge: 2 stitches by 3 rows = 4 in (10.16 cm) of cluster V stitch

### Ch 85

**Row 1:** (dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog) in 5<sup>th</sup> ch from hook. \*Skip 2 chs, (dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog) in next. Repeat from \* across until 2 chs remain. Skip 1 ch. Dc in last. Turn

**Row 2:** Ch 3, (dc2tog, ch 2, dc2tog) in each ch 1 space across. Dc in last stitch. Turn

Repeat row 2 until you have 37 rows.

Knot, cut end and weave ends with a tapestry needle.
