

## Over the Rainbow Trinity Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

<b>Supplies</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• H/8 5 mm Crochet Hook</li><li>• 1 - 2.1 oz – Lion Brand Re-Up Yarn in Cotton Candy or any other worsted weight cotton yarn (60 g 98 yd)</li></ul>	<b>Abbreviations – US Terms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>yo</b> – yarn over</li><li>• <b>st/sts</b> - stitch</li><li>• <b>ch</b> - chain</li><li>• <b>hdc</b>- half double crochet</li><li>• <b>fpdc</b>– front post double crochet</li><li>• <b>bpdc</b> – double crochet back post</li><li>• <b>dc</b>– double crochet</li></ul>
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**front post double crochet stitch** – yarn over, insert the hook behind the post from the front, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. **back post double crochet stitch** – yarn over, insert the hook from the back of the post, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on your hook, yo, pull thru remaining two loops on your hook. For more info [here](#), from yarnspirations.com.

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an odd number for the chain.

Approx. 8 in x 8 in (20.3 cm)

Chain 35

**Row 1:** Working in the spine of the **ch**, **dc** in 3rd **ch** from the hook. **dc** in each **ch** to the end. Chain 1 and turn.

**Row 2:** **Ch** 1, **hdc** in 1st **st**. \***fpdc** around next stitch, **bpdc** around next **st**; repeat from \* until you have 2 **sts** remaining. **Fpdc**, **hdc** in top of turning **ch**. Chain 1, and turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have 19 rows or the dishcloth is square. Cut yarn and weave in ends with a tapestry needle.
