

Floret Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H/8 5 mm Crochet Hook• 1 - 2.1 oz – Lion Brand Re-Up Yarn in Bubble Gum or any other worsted weight cotton yarn (60 g, 98 yd)	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• st/sts - stitch• sl - slip stitch• ch - chain• dc - double crochet
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You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using a multiple of 2 + 3 for the chain. Chain stitches count as the first stitch of each row.

Approx. 9 in x 9 in (23 cm)

Chain 38

Row 1: **Dc** in 4th ch from hook and in each chain across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: ***dc** in 2nd **st**, **sl** in next*. Repeat ** across. Your last **sl** is worked in the top of turning **ch** 3. Ch 3 and turn.

Row 3: **Dc** in each **st** across, working your last dc in turning **ch** 1.

And that's it! Just repeat rows 2 and 3 until your piece is the desired size. Finish off and weave in ends

Repeat row 2-3 until you have 23 rows or the dishcloth is square. Last row is double crochet. Cut yarn and weave in ends with a tapestry needle.
