

Berry Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

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Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H/8 - 5 mm Crochet Hook• 1 – 3 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in psychedelic any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo</i> – <i>yarn over</i>• <i>sl</i> – <i>slip stitch</i>• <i>sc</i> – <i>single crochet</i>• <i>bc</i> – <i>berry crochet stitch</i>
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special stitch - berry crochet – ***yo*** insert your hook into the space, ***yo***, pull through, ***yo***, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, ***yo***, insert your hook into the same designated space again, ***yo***, pull through, ***yo***, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook. chain 1.

You can make a larger or smaller [dishcloth](#) or a blanket by using an even number for the chain.

Approx. 9 in x 9 in (23 cm)

Chain 30

Row 1: Working 1 ***sc*** in 3rd ***ch*** from hook, 1 ***sc*** in each ***ch*** to end. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: In 2nd ***st***, -* berry crochet – ***yo*** insert your hook into the space, ***yo***, pull through, ***yo***, and pull through 1 loop on the hook. Then, ***yo***, insert your hook into the same designated space again, ***yo***, pull through, ***yo***, and pull through all 5 loops on the hook. chain 1. ***sl*** in next ***st***.* Repeat from** ending with last ***sl*** worked on turning chain. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: In 2nd ***st***, ****sl*** in next ***bc***, 1 ***sc*** into next ***sl****. Repeat from ** to end. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 4: In 2nd ***st***, ***sl*** into next ***sl***, *1 ***bc*** into next ***sc***, ***sl*** into next ***sl****. Repeat from ** to last ***st***, ***sl*** in last ***st***. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 5: Skip 1st ***st***, ****sc*** into next ***sl***, ***sl*** into next ***bc****. Repeat from ** to end. Chain 1 and turn.

Repeat row 2-5 until you have 37 rows, or the dishcloth is square. Cut yarn and weave in ends with a tapestry needle.
