## Wide Rectangular Shawl Crochet Pattern

<ul> <li>Scissors</li> <li>tapestry needle</li> <li>H - 5 mm crochet hook</li> <li>4 - 5.3 oz of Lion Brand Mandala Ombre Yarn in Mantra or any worsted weight gauge 4 yarn 344 yd (150 g/315 m) for child size, for adult size you would need 2 skeins.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>yo - yarn over</li> <li>ch - chain</li> <li>hdc - half double crochet</li> <li>dc - double crochet</li> <li>efpdc - extend front post double crochet</li> <li>st/sts - stitch/stitches</li> </ul>

special stitch - *efpdc* - extended front post double crochet: *Yo* and insert your hook around the post going in from the front to back and back to the front of the fabric. *Yo* again and pull through. You have 3 loops on the hook. *Yo* again and pull through 1 loop on hook. You still have 3 loops on hook. *Yo* and pull through 2 loops. 2 loops left. *Yo* again and pull through last 2 loops.

- You can make a larger or smaller wrap or a blanket by using an odd number for the chain.
- The turning chain counts as a stitch through the pattern.

Approx. 22 x 64 in ( 56 cm x 163 cm)

Chain 71

Row 1: In 2nd chain, *hdc* and in each stitch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: In 2nd *st*, *dc* and in each stitch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: In 2nd *st*, *sc* and in each stitch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 4: In 2nd st, efpdc, sc in next st. Repeat efpdc, and sc across. Chain 2 and turn

Row 5-9: In 2nd *st*, *hdc* and in each stitch across.

Repeat rows 2-9 until you have 178 rows ending with one row of hdc.

Cut and knot ends. Weave ends in with tapestry needle.
