

Wide Rectangular Shawl Crochet Pattern

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Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H - 5 mm crochet hook• 4 – 5.3 oz of Lion Brand Mandala Ombre Yarn in Mantra or any worsted weight gauge 4 yarn 344 yd (150 g/315 m) for child size, for adult size you would need 2 skeins.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>yo – yarn over</i>• <i>ch – chain</i>• <i>hdc – half double crochet</i>• <i>dc - double crochet</i>• <i>efpdc - extend front post double crochet</i>• <i>st/sts – stitch/stitches</i>

special stitch - *efpdc* - extended front post double crochet: ***Yo*** and insert your hook around the post going in from the front to back and back to the front of the fabric. ***Yo*** again and pull through. You have 3 loops on the hook. ***Yo*** again and pull through 1 loop on hook. You still have 3 loops on hook. ***Yo*** and pull through 2 loops. 2 loops left. ***Yo*** again and pull through last 2 loops.

- You can make a larger or smaller wrap or a blanket by using an odd number for the chain.
- The turning chain counts as a stitch through the pattern.

Approx. 22 x 64 in (56 cm x 163 cm)

Chain 71

Row 1: In 2nd chain, ***hdc*** and in each stitch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 2: In 2nd ***st***, ***dc*** and in each stitch across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: In 2nd ***st***, ***sc*** and in each stitch across. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 4: In 2nd ***st***, ***efpdc***, ***sc*** in next ***st***. Repeat ***efpdc***, and ***sc*** across. Chain 2 and turn

Row 5-9: In 2nd ***st***, ***hdc*** and in each stitch across.

Repeat rows 2-9 until you have 178 rows ending with one row of ***hdc***.

Cut and knot ends. Weave ends in with tapestry needle.
