Feather Stitch Dishcloth Pattern

Supplies

- Scissors
- tapestry needle
- H/8 5 mm Crochet Hook
- 1 1 oz Lily Sugar n Cream in Soleil Ombre or any other worsted weight cotton yarn approx
- 1- 1 oz Peaches & Crème in Happy Go Lucky or any other worsted weight cotton yarn

Abbreviations - US Terms

- yo yarn over
- ch-chain
- hdc half double crochet
- 1st Feather St First Feather Stitch
- Feather St Feather Stitch
- st– stitch

Special stitch: **1st-Feather St –First Feather Stitch:** *yo*, insert hook into the next chain space, *yo*, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), *yo*, insert hook into skipped stitch/chain/chain space right below the current chain space, *yo*, pull up a loop (5 loops on hook), *yo*, insert hook into the next chain space, *yo*, pull up a loop (7 loops on hook), *yo*, pull through all 7 loops on hook.

Special stitch: **Feather Stitch** –*yo*, insert hook into the same chain space where the last leg of the previous feather was made, *yo*, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), *yo*, insert hook into skipped stitch/chain/chain space right below the current chain space, *yo*, pull up a loop (5 loops on hook), *yo*, insert hook into the next chain space, yo, pull up a loop (7 loops on hook), yo, pull through all 7 loops on hook.

You can make a larger or smaller $\underline{\text{dishcloth}}$ or a blanket by using a multiple of 2 + 2 for the chain.

Chain 24 Approx. 8 in x 8 in (20 cm)

Row 1: *Hdc* in second chain from hook, **ch* 1, skip 1 chain, *hdc* in next *ch*; repeat from * to last chain. *Ch* 1, turn.

Row 2: *Hdc* in first *hdc*, *ch* 1, *1st-Feather St*, *ch* 1, **Feather St*, *ch* 1; repeat from * to end of row, *hdc* in last stitch. *Ch* 1, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 19 rows or the dishcloth is square. I finished with one row of sc.

I did 5 rows of the Happy Go Lucky, then 9 rows of the Soleil Ombre and then 5 more rows of the Happy Go Lucky.

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in ends, using a tapestry needle.
