

## Springtide Cotton Dishcloth Crochet Pattern

<b>Supplies</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Scissors</li><li>• tapestry needle</li><li>• H, 5 mm crochet hook</li><li>• 2 oz -Peaches &amp; Creme Cotton Yarn Happy Go Lucky or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn</li><li>• 2 oz - Lily Sugar N' Cream Cotton Yarn in aqua or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn</li></ul>	<b>Abbreviations – US Terms</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b><i>ch/chs – chain/chains</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>st/sts - stitch/stitches</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>sc – single crochet</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>hdc – half double crochet stitch</i></b></li><li>• <b><i>dc – double crochet stitch</i></b></li></ul>
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You can make a larger or smaller dish towel or a blanket by using 3 +2 chain.

Approx. 11 in x 11 in (28 cm)

Chain 35

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Row 2: (***Sc, hdc, dc***) in the 1st *st*, \*skip 2 *sts*, (***sc, hdc, dc***) in the next *sc*; rep from \* across until 3 *sts* remain, skip the next 2 *sts*, *sc* in the last *st*. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 28 rows or the length you want. End with 1 row of single crochet.

Color change: 4 rows of Happy Go Lucky, 1 row of Aqua, 3 row of Happy Go Lucky, Repeat 1 row of Aqua then 3 rows of Happy Go Lucky ending with a extra row of Happy Go Lucky single crochet.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
