

Springtide Cotton Kitchen Towel Crochet Pattern

Supplies	Abbreviations – US Terms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 7 oz -Peaches & Creme Cotton Yarn Happy Go Lucky or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn• 2 oz - Lily Sugar N' Cream Cotton Yarn in aqua or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ch/chs – chain/chains• st/sts - stitch/stitches• sc – single crochet• hdc – half double crochet stitch• dc – double crochet stitch

You can make a larger or smaller dish towel or a blanket by using 3 +2 chain.

Approx. 26 in x 15 in (66 cm x 38 cm)

Chain 56

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Row 2: (**Sc, hdc, dc**) in the 1st *st*, *skip 2 *sts*, (**sc, hdc, dc**) in the next *sc*; rep from * across until 3 *sts* remain, skip the next 2 *sts*, *sc* in the last *st*. **Ch** 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 66 rows or the length you want. End with 1 row of single crochet.

Color change: 6 rows of Happy Go Lucky, 1 row of Aqua, 1 row of Happy Go Lucky, 1 row of Aqua, 24 rows of Happy Go Lucky, 3 rows of Aqua, 24 rows of Happy Go Lucky, 1 row of Aqua, 1 row of Happy Go Lucky, 1 row of Aqua, 6 rows of Happy Go Lucky.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy

Cut and knot yarn. Weave in ends, using a tapestry needle.
