

Springtide Cotton Kitchen Towel Crochet Pattern

Supplies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scissors• tapestry needle• H, 5 mm crochet hook• 3 oz -Peaches & Creme Cotton Yarn Happy Go Lucky or any worsted weight gauge 4 cotton yarn	Abbreviations – US Terms <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>ch/chs – chain/chains</i>• <i>st/sts - stitch/stitches</i>• <i>sc – single crochet</i>• <i>hdc – half double crochet stitch</i>• <i>dc – double crochet stitch</i>
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You can make a larger or smaller dish towel or a blanket by using 3 +2 chain.

Approx. 7.5 in x 7.5 in (19 cm)

Chain 26

Row 1: in the 2nd *st* from the hook, *sc* and in each *st* across. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Row 2: (***Sc, hdc, dc***) in the 1st *st*, *skip 2 *sts*, (***sc, hdc, dc***) in the next *sc*; rep from * across until 3 *sts* remain, skip the next 2 *sts*, *sc* in the last *st*. ***Ch*** 1 and turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 18 rows or the length you want. End with 1 row of single crochet.

Knot and weave in ends using a tapestry needle. Cut off excess yarn. Block if you want. Enjoy
